PATIENT LEAFLET

Dear Patient,

The following patient leaflet is intended to acquaint you briefly with my practice and its organisation.

My sports surgery practice is an individual practice. The focus of the practice lies in the diagnosis and therapy of chronic or unclear groin pain and differential diagnostic clinical pictures.

The entire practice team will strive to carry out your treatment according to the latest state of knowledge in the field with the greatest possible care and circumspection.

Exceptionally good treatment results are just as important to us as they are to you. This requires not only our knowledge and years of experience in the treatment of athletes, but also sufficient time for the patient.

Appointments

For this reason, you need to have an appointment to be seen in the practice. Emergencies and fresh injuries are of course treated without an appointment.

Private consultation

In addition to consultations paid for by insurance carriers, there is a private consultation. In addition to private patients, all patients suffering from chronic inguinal pain or inflammation of the pubic bone should use this consultation, as their treatment requires an unusually high expenditure of time and cannot be carried out with sufficient care in the regular consultation.

The consultation is Tuesday and Thursday from 10 am to 1 pm.

Patients who make an appointment for a private consultation for chronic pain should fill out the registration form and send it to the practice. Registering for the special consultation for chronic inguinal pain can only be initiated with this registration form.

Out-of-town patients

External patients with inflammation of the pubic bone or chronic inguinal pain can arrange a combination appointment in our practice. This combination appointment includes an examination appointment on Thursday morning and an optional outpatient surgery appointment on Friday. If surgical therapy is not necessary, the appointment can be cancelled without any problems.

Patients who undergo an outpatient surgical therapy on Friday should stay in Berlin until Saturday. If an outpatient operation is planned, the patient must be accompanied by an attendant so that postoperative care or supervision is guaranteed.

After an outpatient operation, an overnight stay in a hotel is planned. Hotel addresses can be obtained from us, if you wish.

Further detailed information, including pain medication and follow-up protocols, can be obtained from the practice.

Postoperative aftercare for patients who are not from Berlin is provided by their family doctor. The first wound check should be carried out at the latest on the 3rd day after the operation.

Important notes

In the interest of other patients who have to wait a long time for an examination or an operation, we would like to ask you to cancel appointments that you are unable to keep by calling +49 (0)30 - 262 33 30 in good time.

There are no regular consultation hours on Wednesdays, Fridays or weekends.

Patients who require daily treatment should consult a surgical practice that provides this treatment.

Certificates of incapacity for work can only be issued after an examination. In principle, it is not possible to issue a certificate of incapacity for work retroactively.

Please come to the planned blood sampling the following Monday at 9.00 am sober. Water, unsweetened tea and coffee, as well as the necessary medication can be taken beforehand. The results of the tests can be requested on Monday from 2 pm onwards.
